

ilm Level 5 Award in Leadership & Management

The **ilm** Level 5 Award in Leadership and Management is a nationally recognised qualification that has been specially designed to support practising middle and senior develop essential leadership knowledge and skills. This qualification is designed for middle managers, particularly those preparing to move into a more senior leadership role, who are required to lead larger groups of people to achieve organisational goals.

To complete the required guided learning hours for the Level 5 Award qualification you are required to:

- Attend a one to one Induction
- Attend 2 units from the selected list each comprising of 2 full-day workshops
- Complete a one-to-one tutorial for each of the chosen units
- Submit the agreed assignment for each of the chosen units

Groups are inter-changeable depending upon Units selected by individual delegates and the length of time delegates are able to commit to complete the qualification.

Additional Units & Blended Learning

Delegates may choose to select additional Units (over and above the minimum required) and study these through our blended learning approach. Candidates complete a Unit Induction, at which they are provided with the resources to complete the Unit through self-study. Additional support to submit the Unit assignment (optional) is provided through email and one to one tutorials. Delegates can select from the full list of ilm Units.

Cost to study additional Units are £265 per Unit (Assessed route) or £215 per Unit (Non-assessed route. Funded, these costs are £132 per Unit (Assessed route) or £82 per Unit (Non-assessed Unit).

ILM Membership

All registered candidates automatically become student members of the ILM for the duration of their programme. Designed to help candidates get the most from their course and advance their management career, studying membership gives access to a wide range of specialist support and development materials and serves. Successful completion of a Level 5 qualification provides eligibility for a minimum grade of Associate Membership (AMInstLM) of the Institute of Leadership and Management.

Investment

The total cost for the programme will vary between £1029 and £1219 per person depending upon the chosen Units. This includes all relevant materials, ilm registration and certification, along with student membership allowing access to a wide range of support and development materials.
